- Legislature can control commercial speech but must be directly connected
- Are there statistics/hard data on preference between local products vs. cheap/affordable products
- Controlling imagery and geographical landmarks may seem difficult and ambiguous
- Timeframes need to be generous to accommodate larger manufacturers
- Fines for non-renewal are too harsh – if a manufacturer forgets to renew, the fine should be adjusted accordingly
