- B.a: Recommend to address “requirement” to have the GPS on products – it should be an incentive
 - Needs to be addressed in the new law – mandate imported products, not local manufacturers
 - Make sure to include that even if you trademark a derivative you are not exempt from the GPS law
 - Sources of funding
 - Charge fees for imported products that use Guam or Chamorro for entry
 - Hotel occupancy tax, extra dollar or 50 cents, half for GPS and half for Beautification Task Force
 - Lt. Governor agrees to rescind EO, suggest to increase STEP grant request to fund GPS program under GEPA
 - Leo Casil to research consumer labeling council
- B.c.: Revise logo with Lt. Governor’s recommendations
- B.b.: Revoke business license until in compliance for multiple violators on 3rd offense.
 - 3 step increase in fines for violations
 - 1st offense, cost of program admission \$500
 - 2nd offense, twice the cost of 1st offense
 - 3rd offense, suspension of business license
 - 4th offense, business license revoked
- F: Clearly define “derivative”
 - CQA shall develop clear guidelines (internal policies) to its officers to identify products in violation
 - GEDA to develop due process for appeals for violations
